

TROY HOMECOMING PARADE

July 24 & 25, 2009

Troy Lions Club, sponsor of the Troy Homecoming, requests that all individuals, groups or organizations interested in placing a unit in this year's Homecoming Parade, complete and return the adjacent application form by July 21st. There will be no theme or judging of the floats this year.

Staging Area: The east end of Market Street at Dewey Street.

Drop Offs: Before the parade, drop offs should be made along Hassinger Street at the east end of East Market Street, or at the Wakeland Center School parking lot and walk over to the staging area.

Parade Route: Start at E. Market and Ash, proceed west through town to Wickliffe, west on Wickliffe to Riggins Road. At this point, those who wish to unload riders need to turn left, go around the large ball field and end at Hecht and Lake Dr. Those that do not need to unload riders and wish to leave the park can turn right at Riggins Road. Parade Times: Friday, July 24 & 25 – 6:00 p.m. start. Please arrive at the staging area at least 45 minutes prior to start time each day.
