2010 Troy/Maryville/St. Jacob Area Chamber of Commerce Regulations and Policies

1. For consideration into the Fall Fest, organizations, businesses and individuals should complete an entry form (below) and return it to the Troy/Maryville/St. Jacob Area Chamber of Commerce.
2. Applications from those who participated in the 2009 Fall Fest will be given priority. All other applications will be logged on and processed on a first come, first serve basis. So that sales may be fair, there will be no duplication of concessions unless otherwise agreed upon.
3. Entry fee should accompany your application -\$10 for Chamber Members or \$75 for non-members.
4. Festival hours are 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. Saturday, September 11th at the Tri-Township Park. Set up time for the festival will be from 7:00 a.m. until 8:30 a.m. After 8:30 a.m., no vehicles will be allowed into the event area. Each vendor will receive an area and each vendor is responsible for setting up/taking down their own area, bringing their own tables, chairs, equipment, plenty of change, etc. All vendors should plan to stay the entire length of the event.
5. For vendors' convenience, plastic trash bags and trash containers will be available on site. The event crew and the Boy Scouts of Troy will be picking up and emptying trash throughout the event. Each booth is responsible for bagging the trash generated by their booth.
6. Participating organizations, businesses and individuals are responsible for any theft, loss or destruction of property of their booth.
7. The contract and all booth spaces are not transferable. There will be no refunds or rain checks issued.
8. Festival Committee reserves the right to refuse any booth not suitable for family viewing.
9. The undersigned hereby releases, indemnifies and agrees to hold harmless the Troy/Maryville/St. Jacob Area Chamber of Commerce, Tri-Township Park, participating merchants, civic groups and all affiliates, on account for damages, injury, theft or losses of any kind to the undersigned property, or for personal damages or injury at the Fall Fest held on Saturday, September 11, 2010.
